They both sound terrific for the cold weather we have been "enjoying". Take a look.....

Soup Recipes from your SDP Presidents

Sue Bower's Tortellini Soup 3 cans italian stewed tomatoes (14oz) 3 cans beef broth 2 tsp. basil 3 links italian sausage (casing removed) 1 Lg. can Allen's italian cut green beans 1 zucchini, sliced 1 cup chopped onion 1 pkg. tortellini noodles \sim 3 cheese (refrigerator section) Saute sausage & onion. Add tomatoes, broth and spices and bring to a boil. Reduce heat, then add green beans, zucchini & tortellini. Simmer until fully cooked, about 30 minutes. Served topped with fresh grated parmesan cheese. This soup is actually better the next day. I actually cook the italian sausage and onion and then toss everything into the crockpot and let it cook for the day. Nancy Genetti's Ranch Soup 1 lb. ground hamburger

Ib. ground hamburger
medium onion
small can chopped green chilies (mild)
tsp. garlic powder
can cream of celery soup
can cream of chicken soup

1 can green beans

1 can whole kernel corn

1 can cream-style corn

1 can Cajun-style tomatoes

1 c. sliced carrots (or one can sliced carrots)

1 can ranch Style beans

1 c. picante sauce (mild)

1 lb. Velveeta Cheese, cut into small pieces

Do not drain any of the canned vegetables.

Brown ground meat, onion, green chilies and garlic powder. Set aside.

In large stockpot, combine the celery soup, chicken soup, green beans, whole kernel and cream style corn, tomatoes, carrots, and ranch beans. Simmer and add meat mixture. When ready to serve, add picante sauce and Velveeta cheese pieces. Simmer until cheese is melted.
