## **Program Report-Debbie Potts**



## **Mom's Lemon Tree**

Original photo and painting by Debbie Poster: Original painting was done in oils, We will use acrylics.

You will need an  $8" \times 10"$  surface. I used a piece of masonite, applied 3 coats of Gesso and sanded semi smooth. Easy to find a thrift store frame that doesn't require a deep edge as for a canvas. You may use a wood surface as well. If you are not comfortable with the technique as described below, DO NOT use a larger surface.

Bottle acrylics – any brand: Paynes Grey and a Deep Teal

Base coat surface using a 1" brush with above colors, using a slip slap motion to blend. Keep the darker color towards the edges of surface.

Transfer pattern using a white transfer paper.

Palette Paper: paper towels: plastic paint tray with the wells for each color of paint (Dollar Store)


Bottle acrylics - Yellow Ochre and a Medium Foliage Green

Base leaves with Green and lemons with Yellow Ochre

I did the whole painting in acrylics using #10 Filbert brush, you should bring a few other sizes such as a #4 round, #10 or #12 flat. There is NO FLOATING used on this painting. We'll be painting wet on wet and using a quick "dry" brush technique with paint in the brush. IF you are a SLOW painter, PLEASE have an acrylic GEL EXTENDER – I will have some to share in class.

Tube Acrylics – any brand. Bottle acrylics are fine, especially if it's a thicker brand like Folk Art or Decoart Americana. Do not use an inexpensive brand. They have too much water in them. White: Yellow Ochre: Cad Yellow Medium: Cad Yellow Light: Hookers Green: Ultramarine Blue: either a Medium Red OR Diox Purple. We will be brush mixing colors. PLEASE be aware this is an impressionistic style and the painting should be viewed from several feet away!!
